

Governance Charter - MOU

• The Continuum of Care designates a legal entity to serve as the Coordinated Entry (CE) Lead. The CE Lead is designed to coordinate program participant initial screening, assessment, and provision of referrals. As defined by HUD, the CE will cover the geographic area, be easily accessed by individuals and families seeking housing services, be well advertised, and include a comprehensive and standardized assessment tool. The roles and responsibilities of the CE Lead are outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding.


Notes:
