## **COVID-19 Testing Results**

**Reporting Period [3.23.2020 - 5.08.2020]** Below is data on the COVID-19 test results for homeless persons in the city of Detroit.

> 562 Tests Conducted 89 Total Positives

Of the tests administered: **38%** have been completed by **hospitals 11%** have been completed by **Wayne State University 89%** have been completed by the **Detroit Health Department** 

As of May 8, 2020 - there are a total of **21 guests** at the Alternative Shelter Sites [also referred to as Isolation Shelter Sites].

60% of referrals to these Alternative Shelter Sites have come from hospitals40% from our traditional shelters and outreach providers

### **New Homelessness Response Actions Taken**

**Updated Client Screening Tool** 

The Detroit Health Department has updated the <u>client screening tool</u> to incorporate newly recognized symptoms of COVID-19. This tool is used by shelter and congregate living program staff to monitor clients on a daily basis for symptoms.

#### **560** total Shelter Referrals

427 single adults61 youth72 families

#### **63** total Housing Program Referrals

Transitional Housing: 7 families, 2 single adults Rapid Re-Housing: 8 families, 32 single adults Permanent Supportive Housing: 13 single adults, 1 family Reporting Period [3.23 - 5.07]

The Coordinated Assessment Model (CAM) is Detroit's coordinated entry system to homeless services. During the COVID-19 pandemic, CAM is operating a phone-based model. Any individual or family without a safe place to stay for the night can contact CAM at 313-484-4449, seven days a week from 7am-8:30pm for assistance.

Additionally, CAM is coordinating transportation to alternative shelters from emergency shelters and hospitals for people who are homeless and also are 1) experiencing COVID-19 symptoms; 2) awaiting COVID-19 test results; or 3) have tested positive for COVID-19.

The bank will waive the normal check cashing fee for noncustomers, which will only apply to government stimulus checks. Individuals will need two forms of identification.
